CPS processes RAD Requests daily, including those submitted since October 4 **	10/11/99 - 10/29/99
Last day for institutions to request RAD Requests	10/29/99
CPS prints and mails EDE-requested Renewal FAFSAs (bulk mail) to schools	11/4/99 - 11/12/99
CPS prints and mails non-EDE requested paper Renewal FAFSAs to students	11/15/99 - 12/31/99
CPS prints and mails PIN mailers to eligible students	11/22/99 - 12/31/99
Title IV WAN distributes EDEExpress (V6.0) for importing and printing 2000-2001 Renewal FAFSAs	Mid-December 1999

*Please note you can submit RAD requests beginning October 4, 1999, but the CPS will not begin processing these requests until October 11, 1999.

**For 2000-2001, the CPS will process RAD requests for three weeks only. In past cycles, the schools had four weeks to make their RAD requests; however, to ensure that all eligible students receive their Renewal FAFSAs by December 31, we had to reduce the request period to three weeks.
