 - Includes associated acknowledgements, error messages, file layouts, and SAIG message classes
- Reminder -- Disbursements will be processed in Disbursement Ref Number order



File Layout Changes

- Originations/Acknowledgements
 - Award Amount will be accepted in \$\$ and cents
 - Modifying Verification Status Code
 - Adding Negative Pending Amount
 - Adding Current SSN, DOB and Student Name
 - Increase in record lengths
- Disbursement -- None
- YTD/MRR/Reconciliation



Edit Code Changes

- New Warning Code for Originations
 - For new Current SSN, DOB and Student Name Fields (#332)
- Changed Warning Code for Originations
 - Verification Status Code (#309)
