January 1, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Began presenting FAFSA on the Web filers with question relating to TEACH Grant Program.
February 11, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Began adding comment code 281 to SAR and ISIR transactions for students who submit new FAFSA on the Web application and answer “Yes” to TEACH Grant question.
February 15, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reprocessed 2008-2009 ISIRs to add comment code 281 to records for students who answered “Yes” to TEACH Grant question during period January 1, 2008 to February 10, 2008.
UPDATED May 5, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Began adding comment code 282 to SAR and ISIR transactions for applicants who have not been given opportunity to answer TEACH Grant question. Includes applicants who file paper FAFSA, as well as those for whom application is generated by school in FAA Access to CPS Online or through Electronic Data Exchange (EDE) process.
UPDATED May 5, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Began offering schools, software providers, and third party servicers two-phase opportunity to test TEACH Grant functionality with COD System.
UPDATED June 4, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Superseded most recent (March 11, 2008) posting of COD Common Record XML Schema Version 3.0a that incorporates 1) new block for TEACH Grant awards and 2) other changes throughout schema to comply with PESC standards. <i>Note:</i> Effective June 28, 2008, all 2008-2009 Common Record documents that contain TEACH Grant origination and disbursement information must be sent by schools and will be acknowledged by COD System using schema version 3.0a.
UPDATED June 28, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will implement Agreement to Serve (ATS) Web site through which students will electronically complete and submit ATS. TEACH Grant fact sheet will be available on ATS Web site. Will implement COD System functionality to support TEACH Grant origination and disbursement processing functions. Will include processing origination and disbursement records, generating TEACH Grant Disclosure Statements for students, and sending award information to DLSS. Will also implement functionality that results in DLSS generating TEACH Grant Notice of Disbursement(s) Made for students and sending award information to NSLDS. <i>Note for EDEExpress Users:</i> On June 30, 2008, will post EDEExpress for Windows 2008-2009, Release 3.0 that will allow school to enter, store, and export/import TEACH Grant origination, disbursement, and response information.
July 1, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will have funds available for school draw down via G5 (formerly GAPS) for TEACH Grant accepted actual disbursement records. <i>Note:</i> COD System will accept actual disbursement records 1) after ATS for applicable year has been accepted by COD System and 2) no earlier than 7 days before disbursement date.
UPDATED September 27, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will implement COD System functionality that supports TEACH Grant reporting and reconciliation functions for schools. <i>Note for EDEExpress Users:</i> In early January 2009, will post updated version of EDEExpress software that will allow school to import available TEACH Grant reports.
UPDATED September 28, 2008	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will update Return of Title IV Funds (R2T4) on the Web to include TEACH Grants. <i>Note:</i> Will provide guidance on using updated R2T4 worksheets in place of R2T4 on the Web during interim period.
January 1, 2009	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will present TEACH Grant question to all 2009-2010 applicants, including those who file paper FAFSA as well as those for whom application is generated by school in FAA Access to CPS Online or through EDE process. Will also include TEACH Grant information on 2009-2010 SARs and ISIRs and add to NSLDS Transfer Student Monitoring.
March 2009	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will implement COD System functionality that supports additional TEACH Grant reporting functions for schools.
