Dear ITT Technical Institute Student:

Our records indicate you were a student at an ITT Technical Institute and were affected by the announcement of a closure of the institution on September 6, 2016. We at the U.S. Department of Education are here to help by informing you of the options available to you.

If you were attending ITT when it announced its closure on September 6, 2016, or if you withdrew from the school within the last 120 days before September 6, 2016, you have two options:

1. Apply for a [closed school loan discharge](#), **or**
2. Transfer earned credit or hours to another school to continue your education in a comparable program.
