Summary

This newsletter describes recent enhancements for school users to the [National Student Loan Data System \(NSLDS®\) Professional Access](#) website. These changes include:

- Grants Page Enhancements

Grants Page Enhancements

Addition of Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant (IASG) Information

Schools can now view Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grants (IASG) information for a student on the Grants page, under the Aid tab of the [NSLDS Professional Access](#) website. The IASG is available to certain dependent students whose parent or guardian was a member of the U.S. armed forces and died as a result of military service performed in Iraq or Afghanistan after the events of September 11, 2001. A student may become eligible to receive an IASG if they are not eligible for a Federal Pell Grant (Pell Grant), but meet the remaining Pell Grant eligibility requirements and the student was under 24 years old or enrolled in college at least part-time at the time of the parent or guardian's death. Additionally, schools can view the IASG Lifetime Eligibility Usage (LEU) table on the Grants Page. The IASG LEU is based on a 12 semester or 6 year regulation, which is calculated based on the percentage of IASG disbursed versus the amount of IASG scheduled. The LEU maximum is set to 600 percent for the total of all IASG awards received. The LEU is displayed as a percent value in the range between 0 percent and 999.999 percent.

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New Enrollment Report

Enrollment Reporting (ER) Graduated Programs Report

The new *Enrollment Reporting Graduated Programs Report (SCHEP4)* provides school users with an extract of students and all certified programs with a current program enrollment status of Graduated within a specified timeframe. The report can be requested for a six-digit School Code or eight-digit School Location Code. The user indicates the Program Status Effective Date Begin and Program Status Effective Date End for the date range of the current program enrollment status of Graduated. Additionally, the report can be limited to a Social Security Number (SSN) and Last Name range and may be sorted by Student SSN only or by School Code then Student SSN.

The fixed-width report is sent to the Student Aid Internet Gateway (SAIG) mailbox associated with the FSA User ID requesting the report.

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The *ER Graduated Programs Report* (SCHEP6) can also be scheduled for quarterly or monthly distribution. The initial scheduled report contains all students at the six-digit School Code or eight-digit School Location Code with a certified Graduated program enrollment status. Each subsequent report will contain students who graduated since the last report was run. The fixed-width report is sent to the SAIG mailbox designated under the Scheduled Reports section of the Organization Profile page.
